Mr. CHUM Sopheamakara was born in 1982. He received the Master degree in Private Law from the University of Jean Moulin Lyon 3, France, in 2006. In that year after returning back to serve his country, He joined the ADHOC National Non-Government Organization (Human Rights Organization) as the field trainer of the Khmer Rouge trial case in Kampong Chhnang Province for a year before he took national examination with success for continuing his study at the Royal School of Administration, the prestige school in Cambodia for training high ranking civil servant students, in 2008.
