He was trained for two years (1996-97) in a special research program under supervision professor Georges Condominas, called Formation à la Recherche de l'Asie Méridional et Oriental (FRAMO), Université Paris VI. In 1998, Sokrithy got a Diploma (Master 2) in History from Ecole des Hautes Etudes en Science Socials, the University of Paris VI, France.

More than 20 years working in the World Heritage Site Angkor, Sokrithy's Main Responsible Works are diversified: Director, Department of Conservation of the Monuments in Angkor Part and Preventive Archaeology (2019-now); Director (interim), Angkor Training Center (2018-2019); Deputy Director, Angkor International Research & Documentation Center (2015-2019); Deputy Director, in Charge of Department of Communication (2013-2014); Deputy Director, Department of Land and Habitat Management (2009-2012); Head of Cultural Research Unit, Department of Agriculture and Development (2005-2008); Head of Archaeological Research, Department of Culture and Research (2002-2004); Head of Conservation Unit, Department of Monument and Archaeology (1999-2002).

His main communications on the Academic fields during last over 20 years has been taking placed about 60 different talks, lectures and presentations given to National and International Conferences; National and International Symposium and Workshop, held at 18 different countries: USA, EU, Australia, China, India, Japan and Southeast Asian countries. He granted some Academic Award and National Medals. Presently, he is a member of ICOMOS Cambodia.
